Multidisciplinary Arts Classes

Dance: Contemporary & Musical Theater

Contemporary dance will introduce students to a variety of modern techniques including Horton and Limon, in addition to expressive styles of movement including Hip Hop and improvisational choreography.

Musical Theater dance will introduce students to a genre of techniques from Broadway musical choreography.

Music: Piano & Voice

Piano for Beginners & Progressive Piano is for beginning to advanced level students interested in learning scales, reading sheet music and composing original pieces.

Victory in Voice is for beginning to advanced students interested in a variety of vocal techniques. Practices in this class will focus on rhythmic breathing, sight-reading, melody & harmony.

Theater: Acting & Improv

Acting & Improv students will have the opportunity to develop foundation and advanced theater skills through character role-play, improvisation, monologue techniques and scripted collaborative scene work.

Writing: Creative Writing & Songwriting

Creative Writing students will learn a variety of brainstorming and work-shopping techniques for composing poetry, short stories, fiction & non-fiction and prose. **Songwriting** students will have the opportunity to develop their awareness of language in a lyrical form, explore spoken-word poetry and more!

Visual Arts & Theater Design: Digital Photo, Ceramics & Life Drawing

Digital Photo will introduce students to the art of composing a photograph using innovative lighting techniques, in addition to enhancing Adobe Photoshop and editing skills.

Ceramics students will discover symmetry, color, and balance found in nature and self-exploration through clay design. Students will also learn how to throw on the potter's wheel and apply innovative glazing techniques.

Life Drawing will introduce students to the *Elements and Principles of Design* through observational drawing, portraiture, still-life installations and landscape. Portfolio and sketchbook development will be emphasized.

Cosplay Mask Making & Puppetry

Cosplay Mask Making students will create specialized masks based on Cosplay Characters using a variety of mixed media 3D sculpture materials.

Puppetry students will design hand-puppets based on a short script developed by participants. Concluding the 2-week session, students will perform a production including props and Foley based sound effects.

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
